BYLAWS REVISIONS

The enclosed proposed revisions to the SRG bylaws are needed to clarify and correct certain issues.

Currently the Vice-President and Secretary are non-voting members of the Board. Each is an integral part of the operations of our organization and should have a voice in the decisions of the Board. The proposed revision makes them voting members of the Board.

In order for a Board Member to keep abreast of the programs and membership attitudes, attendance at both Membership and Board meetings is a key factor. The proposed revision makes regular attendance at all meetings a requirement for tenure on the Board.

Currently there is no defined process to fill a vacancy on the Board. The proposed revision provides such a process. The proposed revisions shall be voted upon by the membership at the October 1980 Regular Membership Meeting and be effective the day of approval

BYLAWS (CHANGES)

Article II- Meetings

Section III-Voting Privileges
Addition-Proxies shall not be allowed.

Article III-Board of Directors

Section I- Number & Qualifications

A. Change from "at least seven (7) voting" members TO "at least nine (9) voting members."

C. Change from "the President and Treasurer shall be Directors" TO "the president, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be Directors"

D. Change from "the Secretary Vice-President and Immediate Past President shall be ex officio members of the Board of Directors" TO "the immediate Past President shall be an ex officio member of the Board of Directors".

Section II Term of Office

C. Change from "Any member of the Board of Directors who fails to attend three (3) consecutive Board shall have such failing called to his attention by the President in writing. Subsequent failure on the part of the Board member to reply to the president or to show satisfactory excuse for the absence shall serve grounds for his dismissal from the Board by majority vote of the Board." TO

"Any member of the Board of Directors who fails to attend three (3) consecutive Board meetings or three(3) consecutive membership meetings shall be notified in writing of such failing by the President. Subsequent failure on the Part of the Board Member to reply to the President or to show satisfactory excuse for the absence shall serve grounds for dismissal from the Board by majority vote by the Board.

Section III Duties, Powers and Committees

Addition- Section D.
Vacancies on the Board shall be filled by Presidential appointment subject to Board approval.

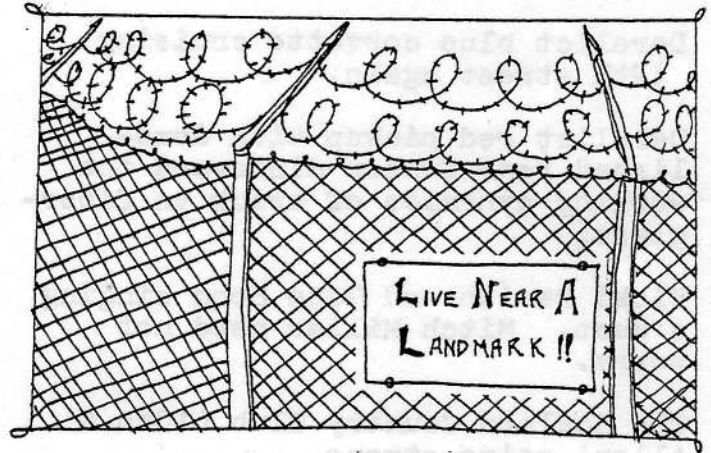

BOYS CLUB

The Board of Adjustment has ruled that the barbed wire on the fence around the Boys Club athletic field must be removed. The 12ft fence may remain, but the Gumbo styled topping is to go.

The ruling was based on the Soulard Historic District Code which prohibits the use of barbed wire. This decision strengthens the Standards and is a recognition of the efforts being made to restore Soulard within defined guidelines.

It is unfortunate that we had to pursue the issue through two hearings at the Board of Adjustment. The issue could have been resolved if the Boys Club had been receptive to our offer last December to discuss the appearance of the fence and how it could be made more attractive to the community.
